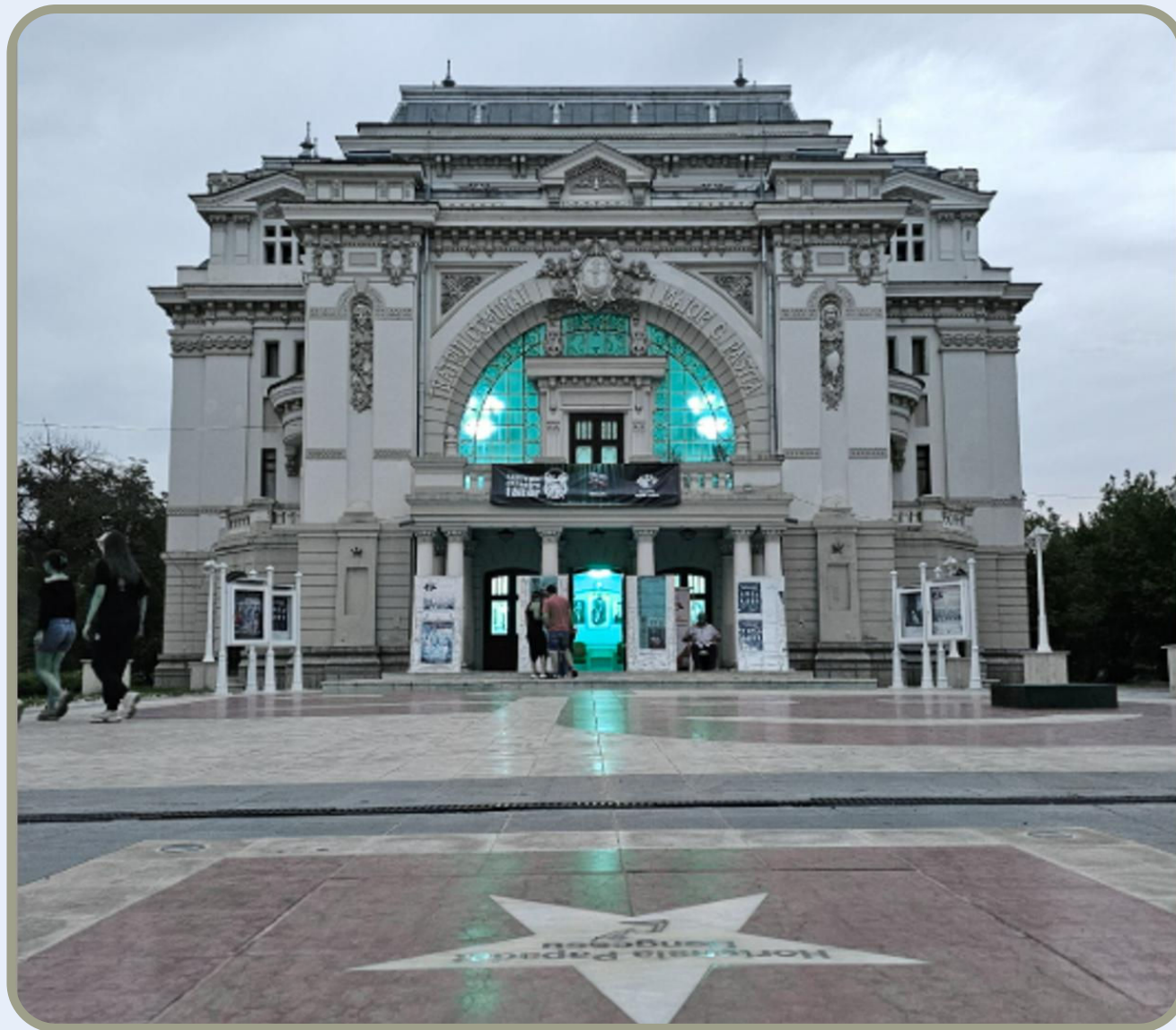


VRANCEA

Students develop hands-on skills through workshops, labs and project-based learning.



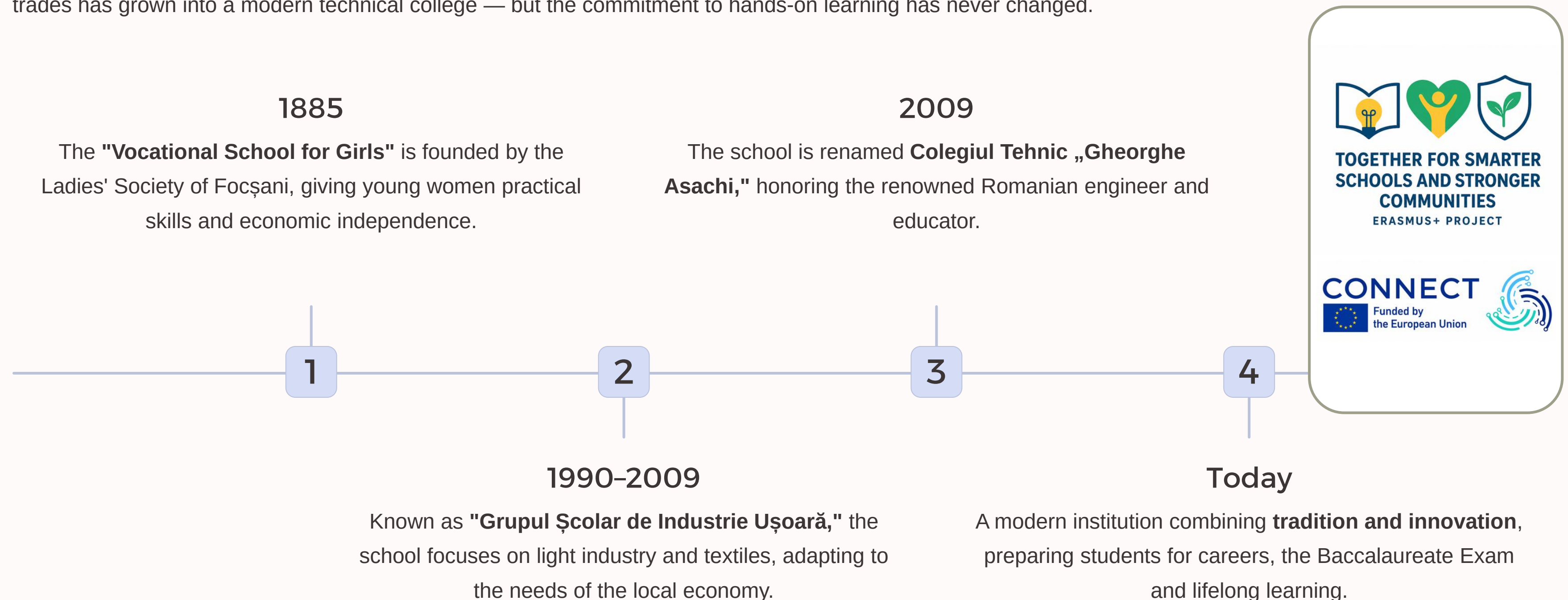
Open to European Cooperation

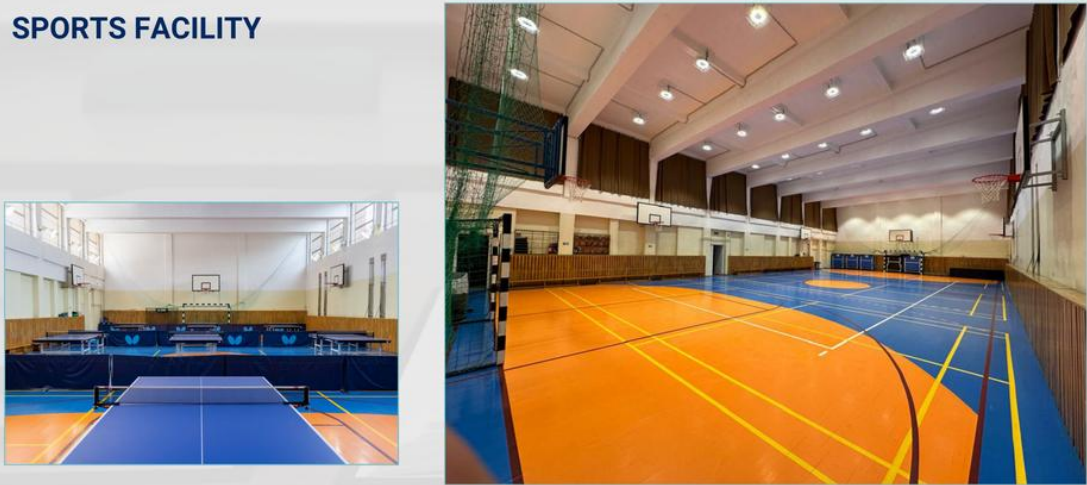

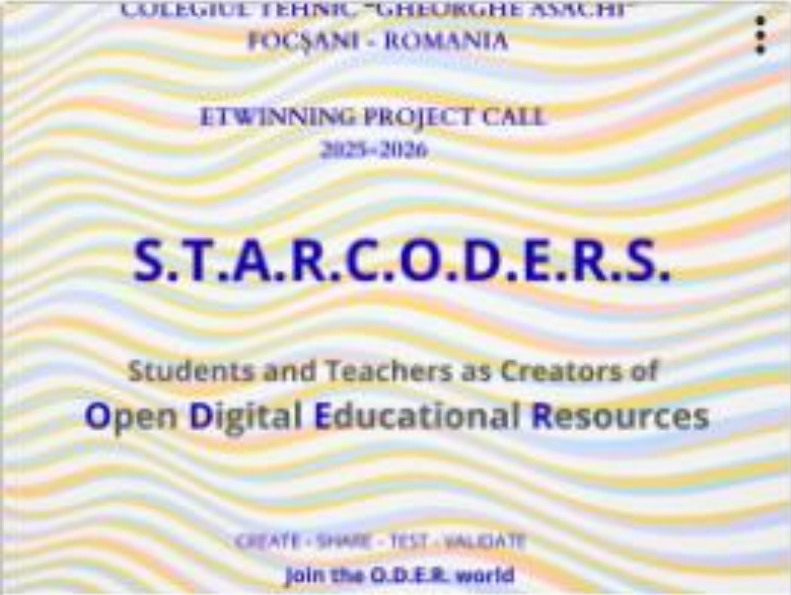

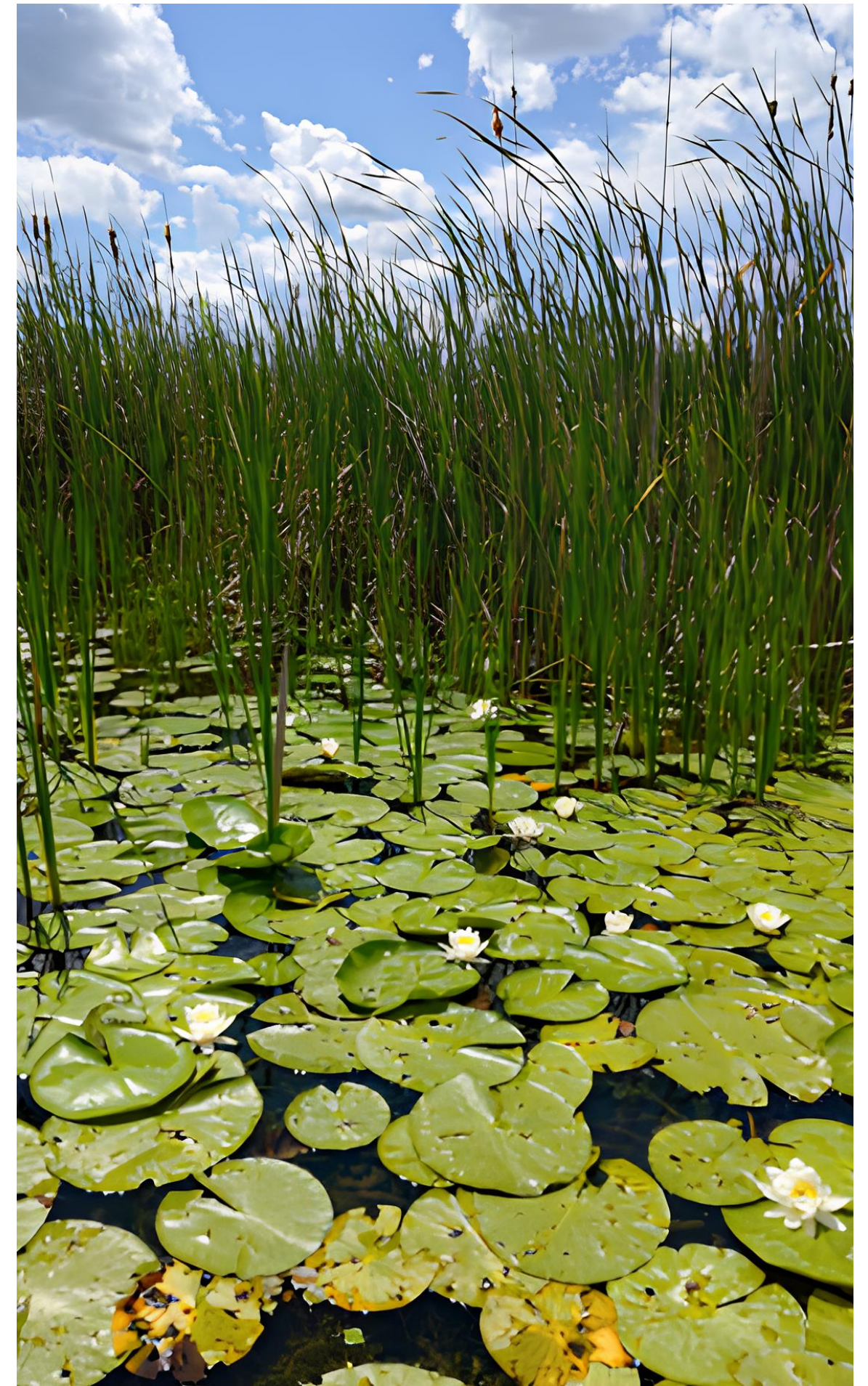
